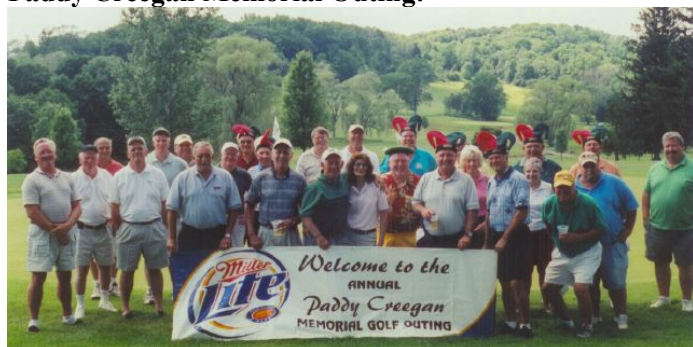


ABCD Tournament:

Finally, after several practice swings he took his shot. The ball took off and landed on the green about 6 feet from the pin.

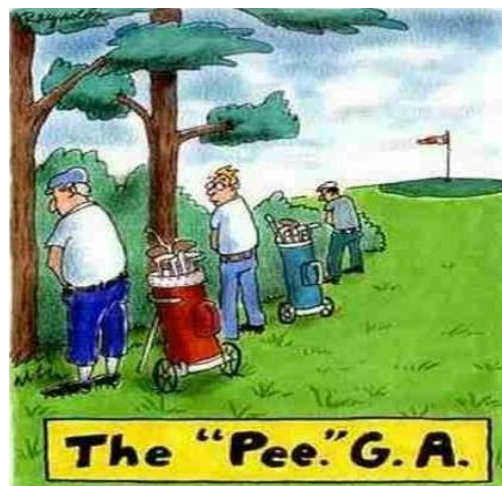
"Great shot!" his friend exclaimed. "What club did you use?"
